Course of Fire: Sunday, September 6th, 2020- 80 shot Across-the-Course match. Firing commences at 9:00am. Targets will be the SR, SR-3, and MR-1. Each relay will fire both the standing stage and the sitting stage before moving off the firing line. Competitors will not be required to stand for rapid fire stages.

Stage 1: 200 yards- 2 sighters and 20 shots for record, Standing, slow fire (22 minutes).

Stage 2: 200 yards- 2 sighters and 20 shots for record, Sitting, rapid fire (60 sec./10 shots).

Stage 3: 300 yards- 2 sighters and 20 shots for record, Prone, rapid fire (70 sec./10 shots).

Stage 4: 600 yards- 2 sighters and 20 shots for record, Prone, slow fire (22 minutes).
