Rules: Competition is open to any safe rifle and ammunition .35 caliber or less. Electronic targets will be used. Competitors will be required to perform scoring duties. Please bring your own tablet (Ipad, Kindle, etc.) or cell phone to use for viewing targets and scoring.

Pre-registration is required on the attached entry form. Entry fees are \$45 per day for adults and \$20 per day for juniors, and fees will be collected on the day of the match. Limited to 65 competitors per day. There is no rain date; the match will continue in light to moderate rain. Match fees will be refunded in the event of a rain cancellation. There will be lunch provided after the match each day, with an awards presentation after lunch.

Awards will be given at the end of each day. Long range and mid range awards will be given for both conventional prone and F-class. Overall winners, rifle category winners, and classification winners will be recognized. There must be at least 5 competitors in a classification for awards to be given. State Champion must be a Pennsylvania resident and a member of the Pennsylvania Rifle and Pistol Association.

Visit readerange.org for a map and directions. Camping is permitted on the west side of the range at the 500 and 600 yard lines. No one is permitted in camping areas forward of the firing line during live fire. There is no power or water available on the range. There are portable sanitation units spaced throughout the range.

Riflemen's Long Range Match-

Friday, September 4th, 2026

3x1000 Yards. Firing commences at 9:00am. Targets will be the LR and LRFC.

Stage 1: 1000 Yard, Any Sight- Unlimited sighters and 20 shots for record in 30 minutes.

Stage 2: 1000 Yard, Any Sight- Unlimited sighters and 20 shots for record in 30 minutes.

Stage 3: 1000 Yard, Any Sight- Unlimited sighters and 20 shots for record in 30 minutes.

Pennsylvania Mid Range Championship-

Saturday, September 5th, 2026

3x600 Yards. Firing commences at 9:00am. Targets will be the MR-1 and the MR-1FC

Stage 1: 600 Yard, Any Sight- Unlimited sighters and 20 shots for record in 22 minutes.

Stage 2: 600 Yard, Any Sight- 2 sighters and 20 shots for record in 22 minutes.

Stage 3: 600 Yard, Any Sight- 2 sighters and 20 shots for record in 22 minutes.

Pennsylvania Across-the-Course Championship-

Sunday, September 6th, 2026

80 shot Across-the-Course match. Firing commences at 9:00am. Targets will be the SR, SR-3, and MR-1. Competitors will not be required to stand for rapid fire stages.

Stage 1: 200 yards- 2 sighters and 20 shots for record, Standing, slow fire (22 minutes).

Stage 2: 200 yards- 2 sighters and 20 shots for record, Sitting, rapid fire (60 sec./10 shots).

Stage 3: 300 yards- 2 sighters and 20 shots for record, Prone, rapid fire (70 sec./10 shots).

Stage 4: 600 yards- 2 sighters and 20 shots for record, Prone, slow fire (22 minutes).
